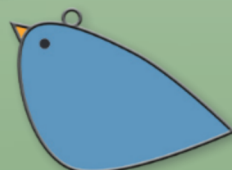

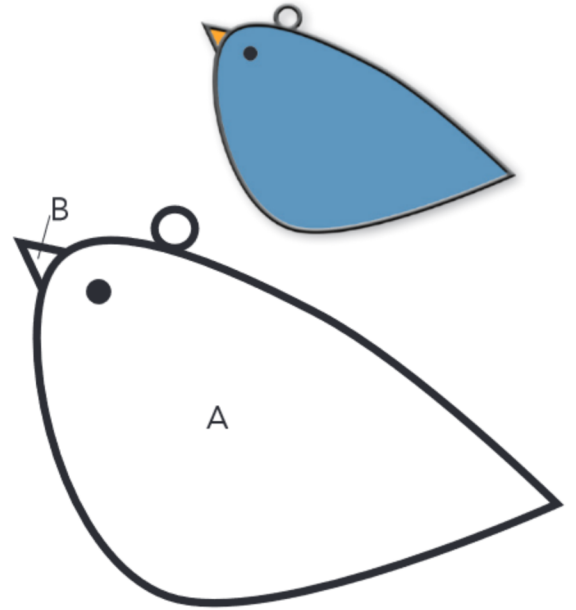


Stained Glass Gift Tags/ Holiday Ornaments

These easy and fun designs are sure to make your holiday giving extra festive and memorable as you enhance each package under your tree with a treasured handmade keepsake!

Notes About Glass Choices

For ornaments meant to hang on a tree, keep in mind the dark green background and rely on brighter greens instead of the more traditional "Christmas green." Opals or variegated glasses are always great choices but if you go with transparent glass, choose iridescents or textured glasses to give them the best chance to reflect light. Add your own personal touch with fun ribbons, or even personalize and/or embellish with metallic paints!



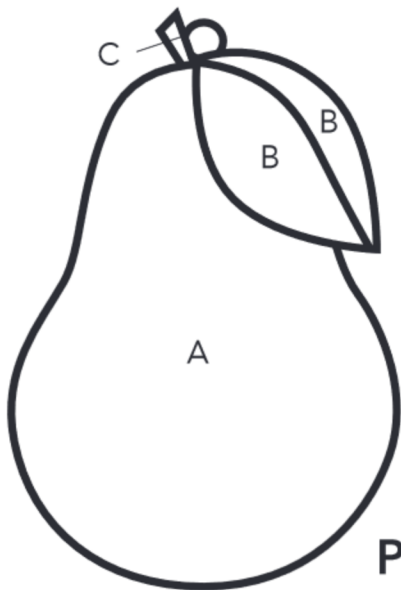
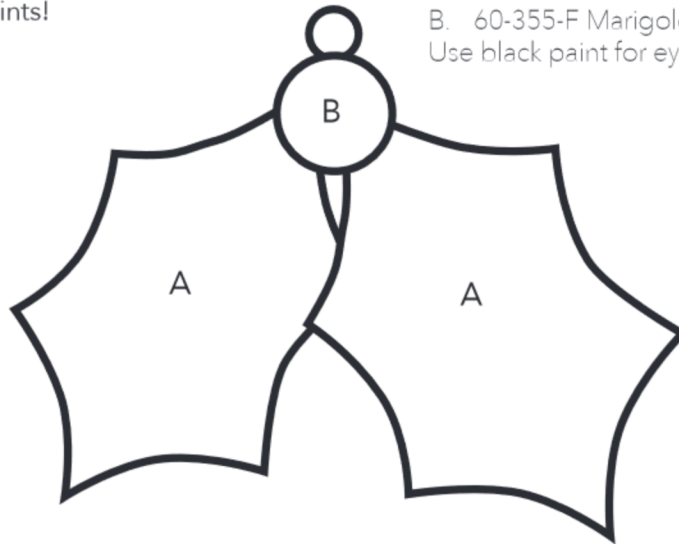
Birdie

Use black paint for eye.



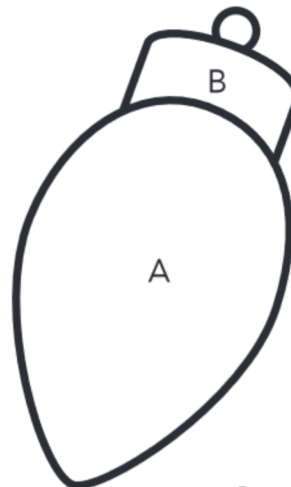

Pear

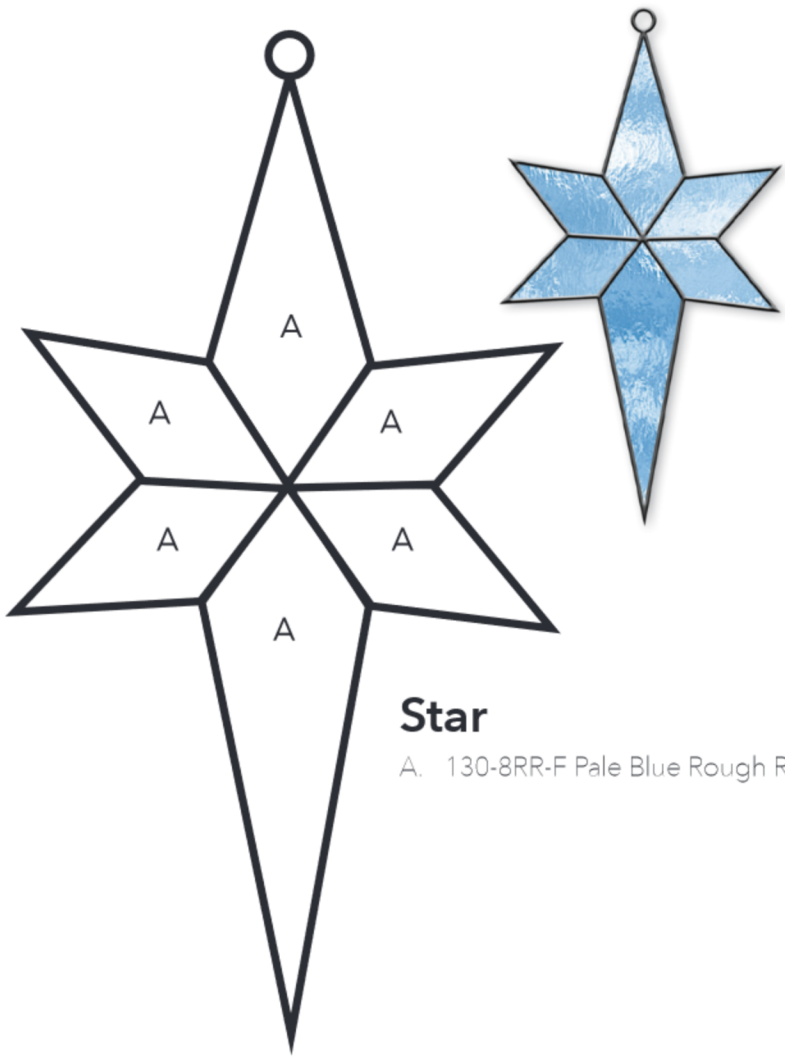

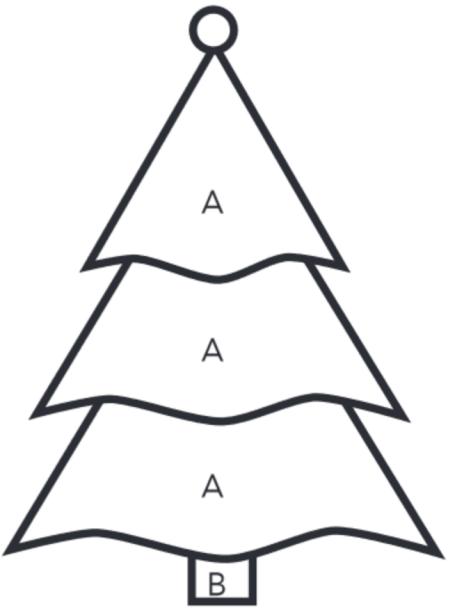

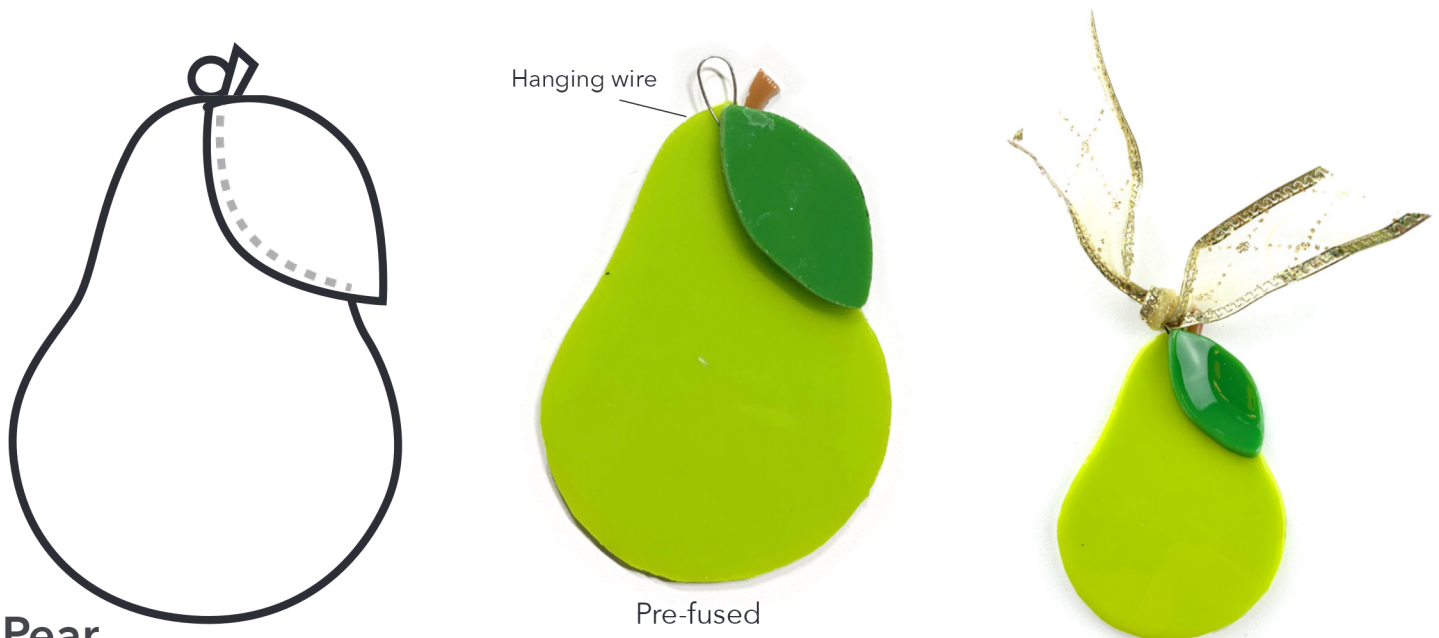
Notes About Glass Choices

For ornaments meant to hang on a tree, keep in mind the dark green background and rely on brighter greens instead of the more traditional "Christmas green." Opals or variegated glasses are always great choices but if you go with transparent glass, choose iridescents or textured glasses to give them the best chance to reflect light. Add your own personal touch with fun ribbons, or even personalize and/or embellish with metallic paints. Always keep a supply of pre-fused dots in many sizes and colors on hand for holiday fusing projects! High-temp wire is recommended for hanging.



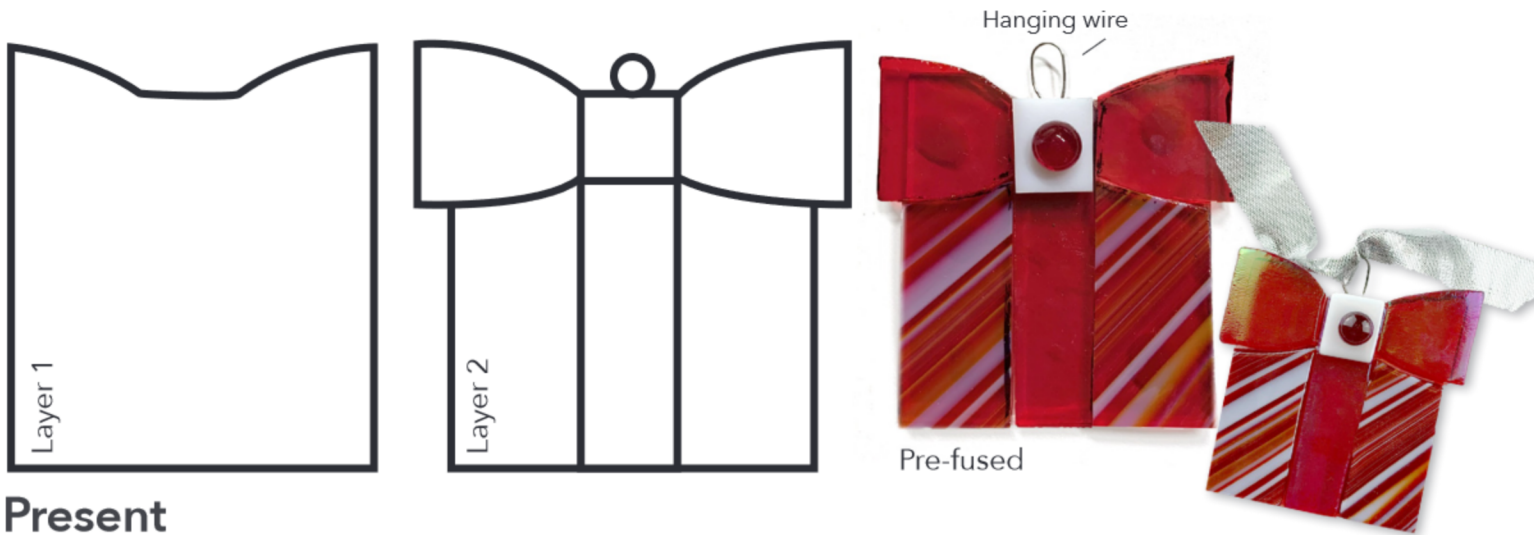
Birdie

Cut two layers of the pattern, using the longer beak pattern for Layer 2. Tuck the Layer 2 beak piece and the hanging wire in between the two bird layers as shown. Add tiny pre-fused Black dot for eye. Use the Tack fuse schedule on page 7. (Note that using a two-layer design allows you to make the ornament reversible! Use paint for the eye on the other side.)



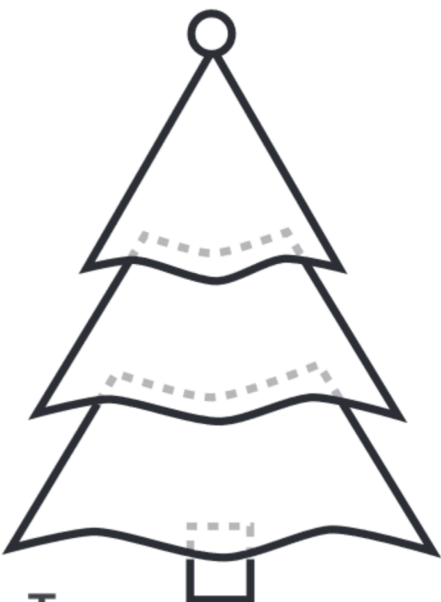
Pear

This works as a single layer since there is overlap of glass to add the hanging wire. The dotted line is the pear shape. Position the leaf to overlap pear and stem as shown. Use the Tack fuse schedule on page 7.



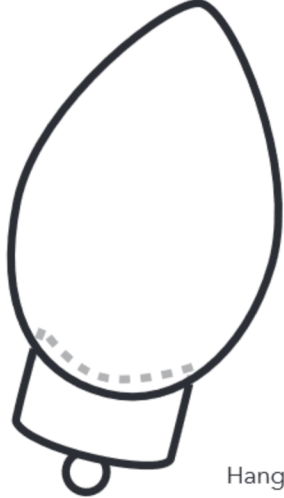
Present

Cut layers then stack layer 2 pieces on top of Layer 1. Embellish as desired with a third layer. The edges of the bow drape slightly after fusing adding dimension. Use the Tack fuse schedule on page 7.



Tree

Single layer design. Cut the tree pieces and overlap each layer as illustrated with the dotted line. Use the Tack fuse schedule on page 7. Note the draping edges add a dimensional quality.



Bulb

Single layer design. Cut the pieces and overlap as illustrated with the dotted line. Add a fused dot to adhere the hanging wire. Use the Tack fuse schedule on page 7.





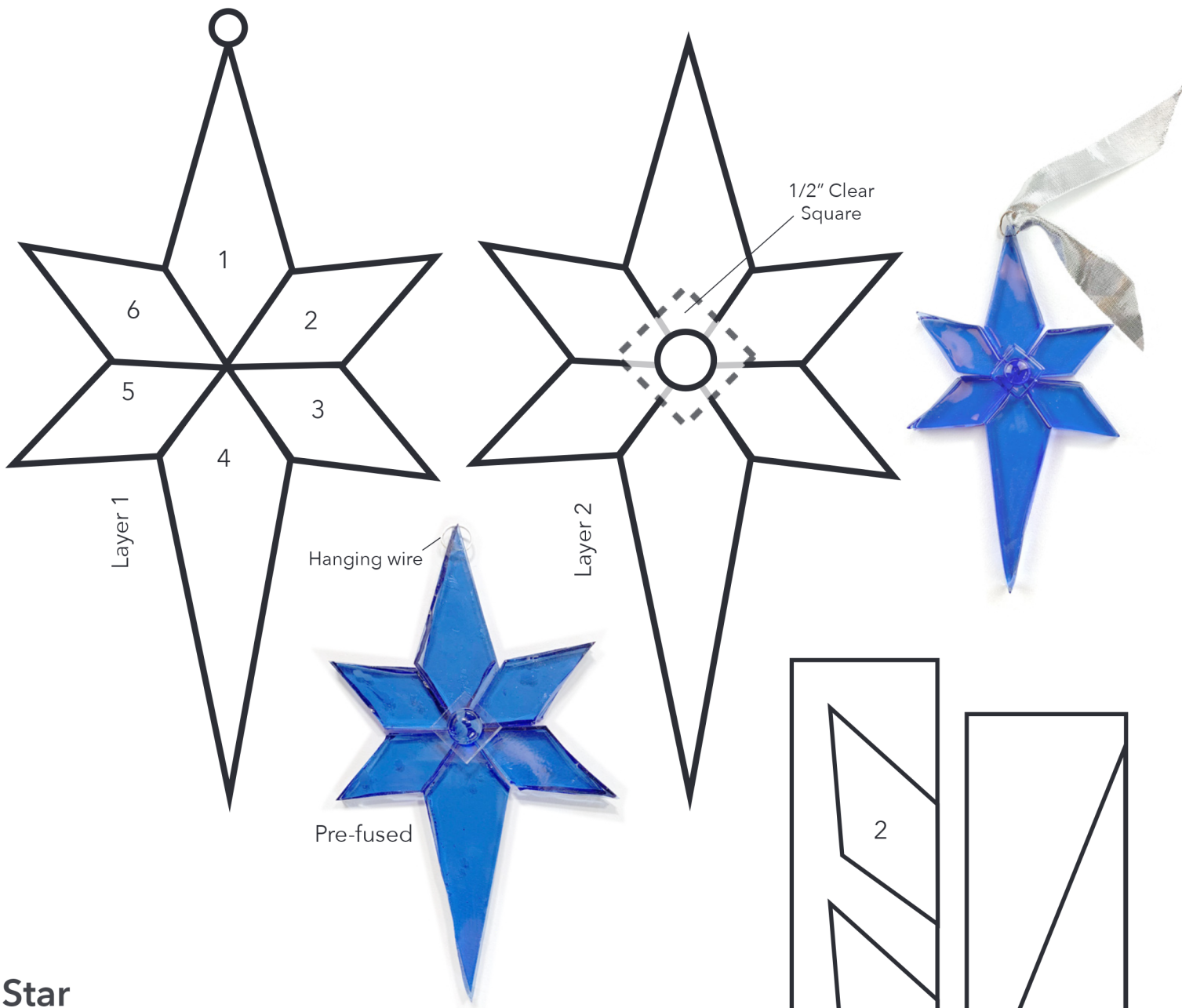
Holly

Single layer design. Add a fused dot for the berry and to adhere the hanging wire. This single-leaf design works especially well as a gift tag with the recipient's name written in metallic ink. (Simply cut a second leaf and overlap for the double-leaf look.) Use the Tack fuse schedule on page 7.



Tapered Ornament

Single layer design. Add a fused dot or other decoration to adhere the hanging wire. Decorate with fused dots, diagonal Stringer/Noodle, etc. Use the Tack fuse schedule on page 7.



Star

Two layer design. Cut each layer using the cutting guide at right and stack. A Clear 1/2" square plus a fused coordinating dot help hold the design together. (There may be some slight separation after fusing, but the edges stay crisp and "star-like.") Use the Tack fuse schedule below.

Tack Fusing Schedule We Used

Segment	Ramp (F°/hr)	Temp (F°)	Hold (min)
1	300	300	15
2	300	1150	15
3	300	1330	6
4	9999	950	60
5	150	800	10
