



Lining your kiln with paper is essential to prevent your glass projects from sticking to the kiln shelf.

We only sell Papyros paper as it is an extra sturdy ceramic paper specially formulated for glass fusing up to temperatures of 871°C. It's fast and easy to clean up and can also be used for multiple firings making it great value.

Papyros tends to retain its paper-like qualities during firings, rather than decomposing into loose dust. The degree to which Papyros retains its integrity can be affected by the characteristics of the glass being used as well as firing schedules.

To use the paper, line the entire shelf, or cut a piece measuring at least 12mm larger than your project (on all sides), then place your glass project(s) on the papered shelf and fuse as you would normally. When you've decided that you're ready for a new piece, either vacuum ensuring you are using a HEPA filter or use a spatula floding over the papyros into a small packet and put into a bin liner. Make sure that you wear gloves, safety glasses and a respirator when handling or cutting due to fibres.
